

### To access home learning resources by Key Stage and Subject


To search for home learning resources by your child's Key Stage, scroll down the Homepage and select your child's Key Stage:







To expand the content to full screen, click the  icon. You can pause, rewind and replay the content. To close the content, click the  symbol in the top right-hand corner of the window.


## Technical Issues
