Dear Parent/Carer,

We are delighted to be able to re-instate our after-school clubs starting the week of the 20<sup>th</sup> September. Each club has been assigned to a certain year group or groups so please make sure you sign up for the one that your child is in. All clubs will be allocated to ensure a fair offering of places across school so your child might not be successful in gaining a place in more than one club if the request for places is high.

## 1. Maths Made Fun 3-4pm

An opportunity for those that would like to become more confident with maths. This club will involve maths games, puzzles and problems; these will be broken down and modelled by Mr Bragg, to help children going forward in their maths lessons during the school week.

### Requirements

You need to be someone that enjoys maths or wants to become more confident with it.

## 2. Fantasy Premier League Debate Club 3-4pm

Linked to the English Premier League fantasy football website, [fantasy.premierleague.com](http://fantasy.premierleague.com), this club will encourage balanced debates, arguments and children's communication skills. Writing and grammar skills studied in Year 5 and Year 6 will be practised regularly in the form of match previews, player transfer suggestions and squad budgeting.

### Requirements

You need to be interested in football and want to develop your confidence in discussing and working with other children.

## 3. Choir 3-4pm

If you enjoy singing and want to learn lots of fun new songs, then come and join our school choir. You do not need to have had any singing experience to join! Children who show commitment to choir will be offered the chance to attend the Young Voices Concert at Sheffield arena in January 2022, but this is not compulsory.

### Requirements

You need to enjoy singing or want to learn to sing. You need to show good listening skills in order to learn the songs. Children who are offered the chance to attend Young Voices must be prepared to learn 10 songs off by heart. All singers must bring a water bottle with them.

## 4. Book Club 3-4pm

If you love losing yourself within a whirlwind of imagination and possibility, join us on Tuesday at Book Club. Build your confidence in creativity and discussion whilst sharing your love of stories with other like-minded people. Each session will focus on one part of the book; involving a discussion so-far and a creative art based activity. Not only will your half term finish with the well-loved story, but also a carefully crafted, book-based piece of art.

### Requirements

Commitment to finishing the book, taking part in group discussions and having a lot of fun along the way.

## 5. Touch Typing Club 3-4pm (leave via the back door near rear car park)

It is a great life skill for gaming, writing up stories on the computer, using the internet or messaging friends. This club will be using Surface Pros to learn how to touch type and is open to Year 4s this term!

## 6. Street Dance 3-4pm

The class will be a Street dance class to learn new dance moves, street dance tricks and will finish with a mini-performance in the final week. The class is suitable for both girls and boys and all levels of dance experience.
