The app learns the things your child can and can't do, and the questions change to make sure you child is always challenged but not stumped. There is a 'help' button which walks you through what you need to do to solve the question – perfect for if your own maths days are far behind you and you're not sure how we teach maths in school any more! Children earn stars which can be traded within the app for different outfits and accessories for their character. Little and often is better – and we don't want children glued to their devices in the evening! Around 10 minutes each day is perfect and is the best way to reinforce learning. More will help, but it shouldn't become all consuming!

The app is free to download through iTunes and Google Play, and your child's username is attached. The password has been reset for all users to 'pockdoodle'. You will need to change the password to something your child can remember once you have logged in the first time.
