Salut! This week we are going to write a weather report – la météo. If you have access to the home learning platform you will need to look for the video Year 3/4 French week 7 PCJS.

Task 1 – Your first task is to write down the four phrases we learnt last week. Try to use your memory but if you get a little stuck you can always go back and have a look in your book.

Task 2 – This week, we are going to bring together all the learning we have done over the last several weeks to create a weather report for France. To begin with, we are going to make a short plan. Here are some questions to help you get started.

Can you remember how to introduce yourself?

How will the people watching or listening, know who you are and what you are doing?

What weather are you going to use?

Where in France is your report going to be?

What compass direction is it in?

Write down a few bullet points to help you plan your weather report. Also, you can draw the weather onto the map I have given you to help you further.

Task 3 – Now we are going to use our plan to help us to start writing.

I've written a short model so you can see how to create your report.

Bonjour madame et monsieur, je m'appelle Lucy et bienvenue aujourd'hui la météo.

Hello ladies and gentleman, my name is Lucy and welcome to today's weather.

Il fait du soleil et beau de le sud et le sud-est de la France. C'est vingt-neuf degrés! C'est chaud!

The weather is sunny and beautiful in the south and south-east of France. It is 29 degrees! It is hot!

Dans Paris, il fait mauvais! Á le nord de Paris, Il y a de l'orage et Il fait du vent. Á l'est de Paris, Il pleut et dix-sept degrés.

In Paris, the weather is bad! To the north of Paris, it is stormy and windy. To the south of Paris, it is raining and 17 degrees.

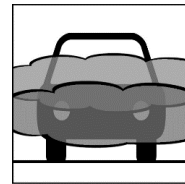

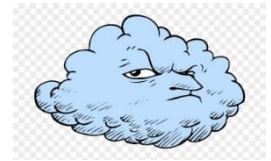
