Task 1: Identify where Africa and the United Kingdom are on a world map.



Africa is a continent (a big piece of land).

Inside Africa, the land had been divided up into smaller pieces. A bit like a jigsaw. These pieces are called countries. This political map shows where the countries are.



Task 2: Find **Botswana**. This is the country where Precious Ramotswe lives in the story that we are reading.

Task 3

If you are working at home without a paper copy, draw your own picture of Africa, making sure that you label **Botswana**.

If you have a paper copy, annotate this drawing by labelling 10 of the countries that are in Africa. Make sure that you label **Botswana**. One has been done for you. Colour the countries to match the colours on the political map.

Draw the line of the equator on this map. Explain how the climate and land changes nearer to the equator.
